- ACTION ITEM: Approval of Prior Meeting's Minutes

- Principal's Update

There are 27 French Applications for next year in 1st Grade so there will be at least 1 class for DLI next year. We are advertising on the marquee and as well as on the fences. We currently have 26 kindergarten students for next year. Our current enrollment is 804. Next year we are projected to be 760 students.

- RISE Scores - Special Guest Ben

- Review SCC Budget & current year plan

Next year, Principal Adams is proposing to use leftover TSSA budget to pay for an extra teacher in 5th Grade to reduce class sizes. It is also proposed to use TSSA to supplement the BTS teacher as well as fund our Instructional Coach. We are projected to carry over almost \$80,000 from TSSA budget and can only carry over \$13,000 from LandTrust. Our goal for this year was increased proficiency. We are doing that through ELL support and Walk to Read Aides

Before the next meeting it was suggested for everyone to review the current LandTrust Plan and data.

- Request for Music

Sarah Wright has requested to attend a State Elementary Music Conference (UMEA). It was voted on as to whether to approve the budget for this from LandTrust. Motion to approve the conference fee and per diem. Jenny Patterson montoned and Natalie Ball seconded. It was approved unanimously.
